**Two Proposed Residential Developments
Coming to Churchill Meadows**

Great Gulf Development

This proposed development is situated at 3015 Eglinton Avenue West, at the northwest corner of Eglinton Avenue West and Winston Churchill Boulevard. An application has been received proposing three 4-storey mid-rise condominium apartment buildings consisting of 169 residential units with an underground parking garage. This development proposal, which implements the Official Plan, allows for pedestrian movement through the site to support local public transit, shopping and amenities.

Daniels Corporation

This proposed development is located at 5118 Winston Churchill Boulevard, southwest corner of Destination Drive and Winston Churchill Boulevard. Although the City has not yet received an application, the Daniels Corporation is preparing a development proposal consisting of street townhouses, stacked townhouses and two-storey townhouses, with an amenity area in a central location on the site.
