FILING AN ONLINE TRAFFIC COMPLAINT REPORT WITH PEEL POLICE

Thank you for contacting us in regards to your road safety concerns. Below you will find the steps to file an online report with us.

Once your report is submitted you will receive a confirmation email and an RSS (Road Safety Services) officer will attend the complainant location and conduct enforcement.

Choose the type of report *in this case it will be **Driving/Traffic/Road Watch** complaint Go ahead and fill in the report - provide exact details in the box below eg. Time of day/describe the concern and how long it has been occurring. The more details, the better. Multiple reports submitted from several residents will only increase enforcement so it is worth doing even though someone you know has already reported.

Police gather data (name, email, etc) from you to facilitate the opportunity to follow up with you for additional information if needed. Your information remains confidential and is never shared with your neighbours.

Make sure that when you are filling out the report and you get to the vehicle/driver information that you click **UNKNOWN** otherwise it will not let you submit the report. In this case it is Unknown because you want Road Safety Officers to enforce in the general area

If there is a specific vehicle (including license plate information) that is constantly driving recklessly then you can fill out the report indicting those details and Peel Police will follow up with that individual.
